## **MEMORANDUM**

**SUBJECT:** RFP 06-011-AZ, Telecommunications Maintenance Services  
Second Year of a Three-Year Agreement  
Verizon Select Services, Inc.

On June 21, 2005, official action (attached) was taken to award the above-referenced RFP to Verizon Select Services Inc. for telecommunications maintenance services. This RFP is a three-year contract, renewable annually by mutual consent of the parties. The first year of the contract is due to expire on June 30, 2006.

Considering the services of the firm have been satisfactory, the vendor was contacted to verify their willingness to enter into the second year of the agreement. They have agreed in writing (attached) to do so. Estimated expenditures under the contract for the next fiscal year will be a not-to-exceed amount of \$755,708.16. This figure per the terms of the RFP reflects maintenance at all schools (including the six [6] opening in 2006-07) and other District locations such as the Telecommunications Center, Maintenance, Transportation, etc.; parts on an as-needed basis; and dedicated Verizon technicians based full-time on District property.

It is my recommendation at this time to enter into the second year of the agreement with the vendor noted above, and we are requesting permission to issue a purchase order not to exceed \$755,708.16 for encumbrance in the 2006-07 fiscal year. The contract period will be July 1, 2006 – June 30, 2007.
