SUBJECT: Permission to Elevate Firms for Discovery RFP 11-020-AZ, Software & Implementation Services for Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) System

On January 18, 2011, official action was taken to elevate four (4) firms for in-depth demonstrations (demos) of their software and implementation capabilities. These demo sessions took place over four (4) full days during consecutive weeks in February 2011. The business functions being reviewed were: General Ledger, Accounts Payable/Receivable, Purchasing, Project/Grant Accounting, Inventory Management, Budgeting, Fixed Asset/Work Order Management, Treasury, Personnel/Benefits Administration, Payroll, Applicant Tracking & Recruiting, Staff Development, Time & Attendance, Risk Management and Fleet Management. To ensure that all presenters covered the same material, for the same amount of time, the sessions were tightly scripted and moderated by our contracted consultant for the project, Government Finance Officers Association (GFOA). The sessions were attended by members of the Evaluation Committee and subject-matter experts in the above-referenced functions.

The four (4) firms were independently scored by the Evaluation Committee members on software functionality, overall system capabilities, and implementation strategies. These individual scores were averaged; Purchasing and Finance Services scored the firms' costs as presented in the original RFP, using the weighted ratio of cost methodology. Scoring results are presented in the attached tabulation. It is the consensus of the Committee that the firms rank as follows, highest to lowest: 1) Tyler Technologies (Tyler), proposing their proprietary software, 2) Cherry Road Technologies (Cherry Road), proposing Peoplesoft, 3) Oracle America (Oracle), proposing Peoplesoft, and 4) Lawson Software, proposing their proprietary software.

We request permission to elevate Tyler, Cherry Road and Oracle for the next phase of the project: indepth discovery, site visits, and Requests for Clarification. Assistance will continue to be provided by GFOA. A recommendation regarding the preferred firm, with which we intend to negotiate a contract, will be brought to a future Board meeting for approval.
