Intra-Agency Agreement for Enhanced Services

The attached agreement is between the Prekindergarten Services, Curriculum and Instructional Service (CIS), Community, Career and Technical Education Program (CCTE) to implement an agreement in which low income families can receive enhanced services including but not limited to a positive teen parent support program, referrals to community resources, access to adult education programs and employees the opportunity to complete the Child Development Associate Equivalency Credential commencing on August 1, 2011 and extending through July 31, 2014.

The specific services are outlined in the agreement and are attached for your perusal. It is at no cost to the District. The services covered under this agreement have been updated and approved by the Policy Council on May 18, 2011. This is an intra-agency agreement between Prekindergarten Services, CIS and CCTE. History

The Head Start Performance Standards encourage the implementation of formal collaboration agreements with existing community programs and agencies that will enhance services to low-income families. An agreement between the CIS, CCTE and the Head Start Program will enhance services to teen parents by delineating what each of the programs will contribute to the effort. The focus of the agreement is collaboration in the implementation of a positive teen parent support program.

Description or Problem

The 2011-2014 CIS, CCTE and Head Start agreement has been updated and approved by the Policy Council on May 18, 2011.

Action Requested

Approval of the 2011-2014 CIS, CCTE and Head Start agreement is needed in order to satisfy program requirements.

Curriculum and Instructional Services Community, Career and Technical Education Program Partnership Agreement 2011-2014

I. Purpose

The Head Start Program, Curriculum and Instructional Services, and Community, Career, and Technical Education Program under the District School Board of Pasco County enter into this mutual Partnership Agreement for the period commencing on August 1, 2011 and extending through July 31, 2014.

The purpose of this partnership is to:

- Work collaboratively to implement a positive teen parent support program through home visiting and comprehensive services.
- Provide referrals to community resources, and opportunities for placement in the Early Head Start and Head Start classroom.
- Provide employees the opportunity to complete the Child Development Associate Equivalency Credential (CDAE).
- Ensure that services provided to teen parents are not duplicated and best meet their individual and academic needs.
- Provide families access to adult education programs.

II. Services

The Head Start Program, Curriculum and Instructional Services, and Community, Career and Technical Education Program under the District School Board of Pasco County agree to partner toward the achievement of the overall objective to provide services to expectant mothers, teen parents, young children and the educational needs of families, which support positive childhood outcomes. The term "teen parent" refers to teen parents who may be enrolled in the Head Start program and/or a teen parent who is enrolled in the district teen parenting program. The term "parent" refers to any parent from the community enrolled in the Head Start program.

III. Responsibilities

A. As part of this partnership, the Head Start Program agrees to provide the following services:

- Dually enroll eligible expectant mothers, infants and toddlers, and preschool age children as openings occur, who are enrolled in the district teen parenting program
- Cooperatively maintain communication, leadership and responsibility to ensure that all available resources are used in the most effective manner, including participating in collaboration meetings with the teen parenting program periodically throughout the year
- Provide parents opportunities to identify and achieve family goals through the Family Partnership Agreement process and build on preexisting family support plans

- Work in collaboration to refer and support parents to adult educations programs, such as GED Preparation, On-line Education, English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL), and Adult Literacy
- Provide parents the opportunity to enhance their parenting skills, knowledge, and understanding of the educational and developmental needs of their child
- Provide parents opportunities to participate in the development of the program's curriculum and develop an individualized plan for their own child's growth and development
- Support family involvement by offering socialization group meetings and parent meetings, parent advocacy, and opportunities for volunteering
- Provide screening, assessment, parent conferencing and home visitation services
- Provide comprehensive services to expectant mothers, infants and toddlers and their families by working with community agencies and health professionals, including resources for prenatal health care, prenatal education and postpartum health care
- Provide support to the teen parents, children and families as they transition into and out of the Head Start program
- Designate a representative to participate in advisory committees, school and community based events, and case management meetings when requested
- **B.** As part of this partnership, Curriculum and Instructional Services, and Community, Career and Technical Education Program agree to provide the following services:
 - Support staff to make referrals to the Early Head Start/Head Start Program as needed
 - Cooperatively maintain communication, leadership and responsibility to ensure that all available resources are used in the most effective manner.
 - Provide the Child Development Associate Equivalency Credential (CDAE) classes at the Technical/Educational centers and sites
 - Work in collaboration to provide adult educations programs, such as GED Preparation, On-line Education, English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL), and Adult Literacy

Duration, Monitoring and Evaluation

The Head Start, Curriculum and Instructional Services, and Community, Career and Technical Education Program will meet periodically to share information, develop procedures and evaluate the effectiveness of the current service delivery system for continuous quality improvement. The agreement will be renewed triennially. It can be modified or cancelled by request of any of the signing parties, with a 30 day written notice.

Dispute/Conflict Resolution

Every attempt will be made to resolve any disagreement to the satisfaction of all parties.
