#### Introduction

Articulation agreements allow qualifying high school students the opportunity to earn college credit for specific Career and Technical Education courses and programs. Currently, articulation agreements between the District School Board of Pasco County and numerous postsecondary educational institutions are providing this opportunity to students.

#### Description

The Articulation Agreement between the District School Board of Pasco County and Keiser University must be Board approved to enable qualifying high school students the opportunity to earn college credit for specific courses outlined in the attached agreement once they enroll at Keiser University. The agreement saves students and parents time and money as it avoids the duplication of course work successfully completed by students.

The staff requests Board approval of the articulation agreement with Keiser University.

# Articulation Agreements between the School Board of Pasco County and Keiser University

Keiser University will award postsecondary advance standing credit to eligible high school students who have graduated from high school and completed the secondary portion of their Career and Technical Program Area. The student must complete this program with a grade of "B" or better. The instructor's credentials must meet the Commission on Colleges of the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Accreditation criteria. The High School will provide evidence that the instructors meet the Commission on Colleges of the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools credential requirements.

The procedure for obtaining the advance standing credit will be in accordance with the following procedures:

1. Student must complete the secondary level Career and Technical course(s) specifically identified in the individual program specific articulation agreements.

- 2. The student *will not* be charged tuition or fees for the postsecondary credit awarded through this advance standing credit agreement.
- 3. The student will be awarded the advance standing credit upon successful completion of the high school courses (3 credits) with a grade "B" or better, after graduation from high school and after having successfully completed one semester at Keiser University with a 2.0 GPA in the program for which the advanced standing credit is to be awarded.
- 4. Following completion of one semester at Keiser University, students must petition the Academic Dean to have advanced standing credit placed on their permanent transcript. The students will be awarded the grade of "P", and the grade will not affect the GPA.
- 5. This agreement will be reviewed bi-annually and updated as appropriate.
