Contract and Purchase Order Approval

The Office for Teaching and Learning, Title I, is requesting approval of the attached agreement with Innovative Designs for Education (IDE) to implement Learner-Active, Technology-Infused Classrooms at Lacoochee Elementary School. Please reference the attached memo from Brian Schultz, Program Coordinator, Title I, Office for Teaching and Learning. This agreement has been reviewed and approved by the District School Board's Attorney, Ms. Nancy Alfonso, on April 24, 2014.

IDE is the copyright holder for IDE programs (see attached).

PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT IN DESIGNING

This contract is made as of May 16, 2014, between:

PASCO COUNTY SCHOOLS

with its administrative offices located at 7227 Land O' Lakes Blvd., Land O' Lakes, FL 34638,
hereinafter referred to as the "DISTRICT"

and

IDE Corp.

with its offices located at 545 Island Road, Suite 3A, Ramsey, New Jersey 07446, hereinafter
referred to as the "CONSULTANT"

WHEREAS, the DISTRICT is looking to provide professional development in designing *Learner-Active, Technology-Infused Classrooms*, and the CONSULTANT is the sole-source provider of such training,

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:

First. Services and Compensation. The CONSULTANT, in consideration of the making of this Contract and a sum not to exceed \$38,495 in the first year, agreed to be paid hereunder by the DISTRICT as the maximum and full compensation, shall provide teachers and administrators at Lacochee Elementary School with professional development in a *DesignShop for Differentiating Instruction* commencing on June 24, 2014. CONSULTANT's proposal:

Activity	Cost
Cohort-Based DesignShop in Differentiation (5 days)	\$7,500
On-Site Coaching for Cohort and Faculty Members (20 days)	30,000
IDEportal subscription	\$995
TOTALS	\$38,495

The consultant shall possess prior teaching/administrative experience and hold minimally a Master's degree in teaching.

Second. Payment and Delivery of Services. The DISTRICT shall upon execution of this contract shall generate a purchase order for the first year of professional development services, ending May 31, 2015. The CONSULTANT shall invoice the DISTRICT for the consulting days as they occur. Payment is conditioned upon proper execution by the CONSULTANT of DISTRICT vouchers and other documents that may be required for the proper fiscal management of the DISTRICT. DISTRICT shall remit the full invoice amount within thirty (30) days of invoice date.

Third. Termination of Contract. This Contract may be terminated by either party, upon giving ten (10) days written notice. In the event of termination, the CONSULTANT shall be entitled to payment for services performed up to the date of notice of termination.
