Recommendation: The purpose of this RFQ is to qualify Construction Managers for six (6) District projects: New Elementary School (site TBD, est. \$17m); Bayonet Point Middle School (BPMS, est. \$11m); Fred K. Marchman Technical Education Center (MTEC, est. \$7m); Anclote Elementary School (AES, est. \$7m); R.B. Cox Elementary School (RBCES, est. \$5.5m), and Pasco Elementary School (PES, est. \$3.5m). Recommend acceptance of Request for Qualifications, per the attached tabulation, as highest-scoring responsive, responsible proposals meeting specifications.

<u>Term of Contract</u>: As a result of these recommendations, umbrella terms and conditions, using the current AIA contract template and per F.S. 287.055, will be negotiated for each project by the Construction Services & Code Compliance Dept. A guaranteed maximum price (GMP) for each project will be brought to a future Board meeting for approval.

Notations and Exceptions: An average of the Evaluation Committee's scores on written submittals (Phase I) produced the following company ranking, in order from highest to lowest: 1) A.D. Morgan; 2) Charles Perry Partners Inc. (CPPI); 3) Cutler; 4) Creative Contractors; 5) Walbridge; 6) Allstate; 7) LEMA; 8) Williams; 9) Ajax; 10) DPR; 11) Skanska; 12) Wharton-Smith; 13) Biltmore; 14) Gilbane; 15) Batson-Cook; 16) Vogel; 17) Hennessy; 18) Manhattan; 19) Ellis; 20) Morganti Group.

Interviews (Phase II) with the eight (8) highest-ranked companies noted above were conducted on June 9-10, 2014. An average of the Evaluation Committee's scores produced the following company ranking for Phase II, in order from highest to lowest: 1) Cutler; 2) Creative Contractors; 3) A.D. Morgan; 4) CPPI; 5) Walbridge; 6) Allstate; 7) Williams; 8) LEMA. Per the terms of the RFQ, the top six (6) firms were deemed qualified for award of projects.

Notations and Exceptions, continued: Phase III of the RFQ, at the conclusion of interviews, was designed to align a qualified firm with the unique requirements of individual projects within the RFQ's scope. Projects were reviewed and scored in the following order: New Elementary School, BPMS, MTEC, AES, RBCES, and PES. For each project, in the order noted, Evaluation Committee members independently ranked the interviewed firms; scores were totaled for each project, with the highest-ranked firm for that project recommended for award. The firm was then removed from consideration for subsequent projects. PES, the final package reviewed, was assigned to the remaining, qualified firm.

Per the terms of the RFQ, we recommend an awarded firm, with two (2) firms short-listed, for each project. Negotiations are held in accordance with F.S. 287.055, with the highest-ranked firm; we are requesting approval to negotiate, in turn, with firms ranked 2nd and 3rd for each project should negotiations with the highest-ranked firm fail to produce an acceptable GMP on a timely basis:

New Elementary School: A.D. Morgan, Cutler, Creative Contractors

Bayonet Point Middle School: Cutler, Creative Contractors, A.D. Morgan

Marchman Technical Education Center: Creative Contractors, A.D. Morgan, Cutler

Anclote Elementary: Walbridge, CPPI, Allstate

R.B. Cox: CPPI, Allstate, Walbridge

Pasco Elementary: Allstate, Walbridge, CPPI
