Bid 12-043-DR Farm-To-School Fresh Produce

Fresh Point of West Coast Florida

Food and Nutrition Services request a \$525,000 increase in the total bid award for fresh produce. The Farm-To-School Fresh Produce Bid #12-043-DR (attached) was awarded to Fresh Point of West Coast Florida on December 20, 2011. The original \$829,867.20 award was calculated using pricing from the December bid opening and purchase amounts from the previous 12 month period. The requested increase includes \$135,000 to cover payments retroactively to September 27, 2012.

Several factors have contributed to the significant increase in total dollars required for fresh produce. First, all school cafeterias began marketing a "Fresh-From Florida" produce item on a monthly basis resulting in more students choosing the featured fruit or vegetable with their meals. Second, the drought this summer has resulted in increased prices of up to 35% on staple produce items. Lastly, in March of 2012 the final version of the new meal pattern for the Healthy Hunger-Free Kids Act of 2012 was released by the United States Department of Agriculture. Effective July 1, 2012, each student receiving a reimbursable meal is required to select either a fruit or vegetable with each meal. As a result, fresh produce purchases have increased from a weekly average of \$30,000 to \$42,000. See attached memo from Julie Hedine for additional information.

Estimated annual purchases are anticipated to change the total bid award to \$1,354,867.20, Special Revenue Funds. Food and Nutrition Services requests this update to our Farm-To-School Fresh Produce bid.

SUBJECT: Farm-To-School Fresh Produce Bid Increase Request

Food and Nutrition Services requests a \$525,000.00 increase in the total bid award for fresh produce. The Farm-To-School Fresh Produce Bid #12-043-DR was awarded to Fresh Point of West Coast Florida on December 20, 2011. The original \$829,867.20 awarded was calculated using pricing from the December bid opening and purchase amounts from the previous 12 month period. The requested increase includes \$135,000.00 to cover payments retroactively to September 27, 2012.

Several factors have contributed to the significant increase in total dollars required for fresh produce. Firstly, all school cafeterias begun marketing a "Fresh-From Florida" produce item on a monthly basis resulting in more students choosing the featured fruit or vegetable with their meal. Secondly, the draught this summer has resulted in increased prices of up to 35% on staple produce items such as apples and carrots.

Lastly, in March of 2012 the final version of the new meal pattern for the Healthy Hunger-Free Kids Act of 2012 was released by the United States Department of Agriculture. Effective July 1, 2012, each student receiving a reimbursable meal is required to select either a fruit or vegetable with their meal. As a result, fresh produce purchases have increased from a weekly average of \$30,000.00 to \$42,000.00.

Estimated annual purchases are anticipated to change the total bid award to \$1,354,867.20 Special Revenue Funds. Food and Nutrition Services requests this update to our Farm-To-School Fresh Produce bid.

Recommendation: Recommend acceptance of bid from FreshPoint of West Coast Florida as the primary vendor and acceptance of secondary award to Weyand Food Distributors, Incorporated as lowest and best bid meeting written specifications. The District reserves the right to use the secondary lowest bidder in the event the original awardee of the bid cannot fulfill the contract. The secondary vendor must use the same criteria with the AMS as the guideline for Invoice Sell Price to include Product Cost plus Delivery. This is an all-or-none bid as specified in bid document.

Term of Contract: This bid is for Farm-To-School Fresh Produce to serve locally grown, healthy foods in K-12 school settings, improve student nutrition, educate students about food and health, and support local and regional farmers. This is the first year of a five-year bid, renewable annually by written consent of both parties. The first year of the contract is effective January 1, 2012 through December 31, 2012.

<u>Notations and Exceptions</u>: Total savings were determined by averaging all prices and deducting awarded bid.

Offers from the vendors listed herein are the only offers received timely as of the specified opening date and time. All other offers submitted in response to this solicitation, if any, are hereby rejected as late.
