The attached interagency agreement between the above-referenced entities is designed to provide mental health services to children that attend R.B. Cox Elementary School, utilizing Full Service School Funds. At this time, we respectfully request your approval to retroactively enter into the attached interagency agreement with the above-referenced facility. AGREEMENT FOR SERVICES AND MUTUAL COOPERATION

This agreement made and entered into this 1st day of October, 2013 and run through the 30th day of June, 2014 by and between **BAYCARE BEHAVIORAL HEALTH, INC.**, herein referred to as "**BAYCARE**" and the **DISTRICT SCHOOL BOARD OF PASCO COUNTY**, hereinafter referred to as the "**DSBPC**".

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, BAYCARE has the staff and facilities necessary for providing certain counseling and psycho-educational services in Pasco County, and

WHEREAS, the school system for which the DSBPC is responsible requires such services from time to time, and

WHEREAS, there is a need for cooperation and sharing of services and resources between BAYCARE and the DSBPC.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and the mutual covenants contained in this agreement, it is agreed by and between the parties that

BayCare will:

- a) Co-locate behavioral health services on the campus of R. B. Cox Elementary School for approximately two (2) days per week. Services will be provided during school hours.
- b) Provide individual, group and family counseling services to those individuals and families referred by school personnel or identified through the agency with parental consent. In addition, the therapist will provide screening for referral, staff and/or parent training/consultation.
- c) Comply with all consent and release of information regulatory guidelines.

The **DSBPC** will:

- a) Provide space for counseling that maintains the confidentiality of the child and/or family.
- b) Provide therapist with computer and Internet access.
- c) Generate referrals with parental consent.

SHARING OF INFORMATION AND SUPPORT:

During the duration of this project, the supervisory/administrative staff of the two agencies will communicate and cooperate on matters of mutual concern.

Per Florida Statute 1012.32, the agency acknowledges that a Level 2 fingerprint screening is required of any individual who has direct contact with students while delivering services under the provision of this agreement. The agency will provide the names of specific employees who will provide services through direct contact with students and will cooperate with the School Board in meeting the requirements of the referenced statute.

FINANCIAL AGREEMENT:



Total Disbursement to the BayCare is \$4,500.00 to be used for the following services:

- a. Prevention/Intervention Groups at a rate of \$80.00 dollars.
- b. Training/Consultation Fees at a rate of \$150.00 dollars.
- c. **Screening** at a rate of \$60.00 dollars per event.

The above figures are estimates based on the goals and objectives as outlined in the project. The final costs may vary slightly depending on the completions of these objectives. **BAYCARE** shall provide a monthly accounting of services delivered and the **DSBPC** shall remit payments to **BAYCARE** accordingly.

<u>HOLD HARMLESS:</u> Each of the parties to this Agreement hereby agrees to indemnify and hold the other party hereto harmless from and against all damages of any nature whatsoever which are caused or materially contributed to by the negligent acts of any officer, employee, and agent or other representative of the indemnifying party and which are not caused or materially contributed to by any officer, employee, agent or other representative of the indemnified party.

To the extent required by §119.0701, Florida Statute (2013), the Parties agree that public records created regarding this agreement shall be made available for requests and retained in accordance with the provisions of law.
