RE: Requesting Dollar Approval for Heinemann

The Office for Student Support Programs and Services is anticipating expenditures in the amount up to \$200,000 for curriculum from Heinemann for the remainder of fiscal year 2014. Purchases from Heinemann are exempt from the competitive pricing requirements as outlined in DOE's Section 6A-1.012(11)(b) as they are the sole source publisher for these products. These expenditures are necessary to purchase curriculum for ESE programs throughout the District.

At this time, it is my recommendation to allow purchase orders to be processed to Heinemann not to exceed \$200,000 for the period of January 22, 2014 through June 30, 2014. IDEA Part B Entitlement grant funds will be used for these purchases.
