SUBJECT: Purchase of Replacement School Buses

Suburban Propane

We are requesting permission to utilize the Florida Department of Education bid #2013-01 to purchase replacement school buses for student transportation needs. The Florida Department of Education bid term date is November 1, 2012 through June 30, 2014.

Per Doe Rule 6A-1.013, Pool Purchases, two or more Districts may jointly pool their requirements and resources to designate one School Board or the Department of Education to act as agent for all in the requisitioning, bidding and purchasing of services or commodities. The Transportation Services Maintenance Department, is requesting to purchase a total of (15) fifteen replacement school buses; (13) thirteen Blue Bird -BBCV, Propane and (2) two Blue Bird - BBCV, Diesel Wheelchair Lift. The total expenditure will be \$1,431,088 using capital project funds.

Additionally, the Transportation Services Maintenance Department is requesting Board approval to purchase liquid propane on an as needed basis, utilizing the vendor Suburban Propane through the Florida Department of Management Services (DMS) Bid #405-200-13-1. Suburban Propane will install auto gas fuel systems at no cost to the district. The approximate total expenditure for the liquid propane will be \$200,000 using operational funds.

3. **TERM; EARLY TERMINATION:** This Agreement shall continue for an initial term of 3 year(s) from the date hereof and thereafter shall automatically renew on a year to year basis unless terminated at the end of the initial term or subsequent anniversary dates by either party upon not less

than sixty (60) days prior written notice to the other party. If during the term of this Agreement Customer shall purchase from a supplier other than Seller Propane for use in Equipment, Seller may elect to terminate this Agreement for Customer's breach.

- 4. **PAYMENT TERMS AND POLICY:** Invoices shall be due and payable upon Customer's receipt thereof. If Customer's credit shall for any cause be deemed unsatisfactory by Seller, Seller shall have the right to require payment in advance before making further deliveries. Invoices remaining unpaid more than thirty (30) days from Invoice date shall be subject to a Late Payment Charge consistent with applicable law. Without further notice, Seller may suspend Propane delivery and remove Equipment for non-payment of Invoice(s) more than sixty (60) days from Invoice date(s). Reinstallation of Equipment after a suspension is subject to a Reinstallation Charge. Title to Propane shall transfer from Seller to Customer upon delivery. Equipment Deposits shall not earn interest unless required by law. Customer shall pay all taxes, and for all licenses, permits or inspections, imposed by governmental entities in connection with the sale, installation, storage or use of Propane sold or Equipment leased hereunder, and all costs associated with Customer's compliance with Sections 5 and 6 hereof, including training or re-training of its employees/agents and Schedule A.
- 5. **CUSTOMER'S RESPONSIBILITIES:** Customer, at its sole cost and expenses, shall be responsible for, and Seller's obligations under this Agreement shall be expressly pre-conditioned upon, Customer's timely provision, installation, operation, security and maintenance of each item necessary to Customer's Auto Gas Dispenser Operation, including, without limitation, vehicles, each item checked in Schedule A set forth below, and trained personnel as required by law, regulation and this Agreement. In addition, Customer shall notify Seller of changes in fuel consumption that may require adjustment of volume and/or frequency of fuel and/or Equipment deliveries.
- 6. SAFETY: The parties agree:
- a. Seller shall provide one group initial training session to Customer and its designated employees/agents and shall provide Customer with initial training materials. This Agreement incorporates by reference Suburban's Dispensing Propane Safely training certification, training agreements and training instructions for Customer's employees/agents. Customer shall perform all of its obligations set forth therein, including, without limitation, the responsibility to train/re-train its employees/agents, or cause them to be trained/re-trained, in proper procedures before allowing any employee/agent to use the Equipment. Customer shall keep accurate records of all training and/or re-training conducted by Customer or on its behalf.
- b. Customer acknowledges that Seller has no means of control over the Propane or its uses after the Propane is delivered to Customer. Customer shall provide adequate safety information and warnings to Customer's employees/agents concerning the safe handling, use and transportation of Propane, and the limitations of Propane odorants. Customer shall ensure that its employees/agents are familiar with the odor of Propane. Customer acknowledges that safety information and warnings are available from the Propane Education & Research Council or from Seller or third parties.
- c. Customer warrants that it shall maintain Customer's Autogas Dispenser Operation, including the autogas transfer area, in accordance with, and shall comply with all other provisions of, NFPA, DOT and all other applicable laws, codes, regulations and the requirements of any authority having jurisdiction.
- d. Customer agrees that Seller is not responsible to train Customer's employees/agents with respect to Propane vehicle use or safety, fueling or operation and/or any OSHA regulations or requirements.
- e. Customer warrants that it and its employees and agents have all requisite licenses, training and technical experience to operate the Equipment and conduct Customer's Autogas Dispenser Operation. Customer agrees to provide all its employees and agents who may have contact with Equipment and all end users of the Propane sold hereunder with appropriate safety information and warnings. Customer acknowledges that a copy of Suburban's Material Data Safety Sheet for Propane is attached to this Agreement and that additional safety information including copies of Suburban's Material Safety Data Sheet for Propane in Spanish, if not provided with this contract, are available at www.suburbanpropane.com or 1-888-223-0029.
- f. Customer shall operate and maintain all of its Propane vehicles in a safe and roadworthy manner and condition and in compliance with all applicable laws, regulations and vehicle manufacturer instructions.
- g. This Agreement can be terminated by Seller immediately for any Customer failure to train or any safety violation not promptly remedied.
- 7. MAINTENANCE; ACCESS; SERVICE: Customer shall not service or make any alterations to the Equipment and shall not remove any valves, gauges, fittings or other appurtenances. At all times Customer shall grant Seller the right and ability to have necessary access (without risk or liability for trespass) to Equipment in order to inspect, change or remove all or part of the Equipment. Customer shall not tamper with Equipment and shall not move it from its original installation location, or part with its possession or encumber the Equipment in any way, and shall surrender the Equipment to Seller upon any termination of this Agreement in the same condition as received, normal wear excepted. Customer agrees to notify Seller immediately, both orally and in writing, of any apparent malfunction in Equipment so that Seller may repair such malfunction. Customer agrees to pay for any diagnostic or service work and parts provided by Suburban for Customer-owned equipment, if offered, in accordance with mutually agreed upon labor rates and parts charges.
- 8. **TERMINATION:** Customer hereby grants Seller the absolute right upon termination to remove its Equipment without notice to Customer or process of law. Upon termination of this Agreement, Customer shall be solely responsible to pay for all costs associated with removing Equipment. It is further agreed that Seller shall not be liable for any injury or damage to the Delivery Address or any property of Customer located thereon occasioned by removal of Seller's Equipment, except arising out of the sole negligence of Seller. Upon any termination of this Agreement not resulting from a default by Seller, Customer agrees to pay all of Seller's Charges relating to termination of service.
- 9. **INSURANCE:** While this Agreement remains in effect, Customer shall maintain commercial general liability ("CGL") insurance coverage with minimum limits of \$1,000,000 per occurrence and \$2,000,000 in the aggregate, including products liability, completed operations, and contractual liability coverages with an insurance company that has a B+ or better rating from the A.M. Best Company. Customer shall also maintain commercial automobile liability insurance with a combined single limit of \$1,000,000 and workers' compensation and employers' liability with limits acceptable to Seller that are not less than minimum statutory limits. Customer shall not engage in Dispenser Operation under this Agreement unless the insurance required by this Section is in full force. At Suburban's request, Customer shall provide it with a Certificate of Insurance and endorsements, in forms acceptable to Seller, that evidence such insurance coverage and name "Suburban Propane Partners, L.P. and its subsidiaries, affiliates and successors" as an additional insured with respect to Customer's CGL and commercial automobile insurance policies. The Certificate of Insurance and endorsements must further provide that the insurance will not be canceled or materially changed without first providing thirty (30) days prior written notice to the Certificate Holder. Customer shall provide Suburban with the required Certificate of Insurance and endorsements for each new or renewal policy term on or before the effective date of new or renewed insurance coverage. While this Agreement remains in effect, Seller shall maintain CGL and other appropriate insurance coverages, in accordance with standard industry practice.
- 10. RELEASE AND INDEMNIFICATION OF SUBURBAN; DAMAGES; LIMITATION OF ACTION. <u>Customer, for itself, its employees and agents, and all other third parties, hereby releases Suburban, waives all claims against Suburban, agrees not to sue Suburban, and agrees to indemnify and hold Suburban harmless from any and all liability, injuries, claims, losses, damages (including consequential damages), lost profits, costs, expenses, and causes of action arising out of or related to (1) any personal injury, including death, or any property damage that may be sustained unless resulting from the sole negligence or any other actionable conduct of Suburban; (2) Customer's use of Equipment or tampering or unauthorized servicing thereof; (3) installation, removal, use, misuse, breakage or malfunction of equipment or piping not owned by Suburban; (4) any Customer-owned bridge failure or other premises liability; (5) exhaustion of</u>

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Customer's Propane supply; (6) service discontinuance; (7) Customer's autogas operation; (8) Customer's breach of this Agreement; (9) any negligent acts or omissions on part of Customer. Customer, for itself, its employees and agents, and all other third parties, hereby agrees that Suburban's liability shall be limited to proven direct damages, not to exceed the actual amounts paid by Customer to Suburban over the twelve (12) month period prior to the events giving rise to the claim. No demand, claim, suit, or action shall be made or brought against Suburban, its related business units, employees, agents, assigns or successors more than two (2) years after the date of the event that caused any injury, damage or loss. This paragraph shall survive the termination of expiration of this Agreement.

- 11. **UNCONTROLLABLE INTERRUPTION OF SERVICE:** Seller shall not be liable to Customer or other party for failure to supply Propane or for any delay, loss or damage, or any failure to perform this Agreement due to any of the following "force majeure" conditions: flood, fire, adverse weather or environmental condition, explosion, power blackout, strike, labor dispute, embargo, inability to obtain sufficient or suitable materials, acts or omissions of carriers or transportation facilities, government order or regulation, terrorist act, war, act of God, or any other cause beyond Seller's reasonable control.
- 12. **DEFAULT:** Should either party default on any material condition of this Agreement, including, without limitation, abandoning any autogas operation site and permitting the same to remain unoccupied for more than thirty (30) days, institution of bankruptcy or insolvency proceedings involving Customer, or any of its principals, or any purported sale, pledge, transfer, assignment, hypothecation or encumbrance, in whole or in part, of any Equipment, then the non-defaulting party shall have the option to cancel this Agreement upon providing thirty (30) days prior written notice to the defaulting party of its intent to cancel this Agreement by reason of such default and such default not being cured within such notice period; except that Seller may elect to terminate this Agreement immediately if Customer fails to make any payment or maintain insurance coverage as required hereunder or for any Customer failure to train, or perform Customer's Sections 5 and 6 and Schedule A obligations hereunder, or for any safety violation not promptly remedied.
- 13. NO WAIVER; SEVERABILITY: No delay on the part of either party in exercising any of its rights hereunder shall prevent the exercise of such rights at a later date, and any waiver of any breach of this Agreement by either party shall not be deemed a waiver of any other or subsequent breach thereof. Should any section or clause of this Agreement be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, it is agreed that the balance of this Agreement shall continue in full legal force and effect.
- 14. SUCCESSORS; ASSIGNMENT; SUBCONTRACTING; NOTICES: This Agreement shall inure to the benefit of and be binding upon the parties and their respective successors, legal representatives and assigns, except that Customer shall not assign this Agreement without the written consent of Seller. It is agreed that Seller may assign this Agreement to its affiliates at any time. Suburban also reserves the right to subcontract any or all of its obligations under this Agreement. All communications and notices provided for or permitted hereunder shall be effectively given if in writing and mailed postage prepaid (certified mail for termination notices) to the respective address set forth above. Customer authorizes Seller to leave a notice at the Delivery Address of any condition preventing Propane delivery or resulting in service discontinuance or otherwise requiring Customer's attention.
- 15. **APPLICABLE LAW; ENTIRE AGREEMENT:** This Agreement shall be construed in accordance with the laws of the jurisdiction of Suburban's address set forth above. Subject to Suburban's right, as set forth in this Agreement, to unilaterally change Prices and Fees at any time, this Agreement may only be amended by a writing executed by both parties, and provisions herein may only be waived by Seller in writing. Any Addendum to this Agreement is governed by the terms and conditions set forth herein unless otherwise expressly stated in such Addendum.
- 16. **CUSTOMER'S CREDIT CHECK AUTHORIZATION**: Customer has authorized or hereby authorizes Suburban to conduct a credit check to evaluate Customer's credit prior to Suburban's acceptance of this Agreement.
- 17. CUSTOMER'S REPRESENTATION: By signing below, Customer acknowledges that Customer and its employees and agents having contact with Propane and/or Equipment have become familiar with the odor of Propane and have received a copy of Suburban's Material Safety Data Sheet attached hereto.
